Price Child Health and Welfare Journalism Awards: Nomination Process

The nomination process for the 2016 Price Child Health and Welfare Journalism Awards is now open.

Nominations must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 8, 2016.

The Price Child Health and Welfare Journalism Award, administered with the assistance of the Children's Advocacy Institute (CAI), recognizes significant stories, series, or bodies of work that advance the understanding of, and enhance public discourse on, child health and well-being issues in California, including child health / health care reform; nutrition; child safety; child poverty; child care; education; child abuse; foster care; former foster youth / transition issues; juvenile justice; children with special needs, and others. All stories or series published by a major daily or weekly California newspaper from July 1, 2015—June 30, 2016 are eligible for nomination.

Also, CAI will accept submissions from other forms of media in California, including blogs, websites, television, radio, etc., that made a significant contribution to the understanding and discussion of child-related issues during the period of July 1, 2015—June 30, 2016.

A selection committee will choose the most outstanding submissions from among the nominated entries. We ask that all winners allow us to post an electronic copy of the winning works on CAI's website or allow us to link to them from our website.

To submit an entry for consideration, please email CAI Administrative Director Elisa Weichel at eweichel@sandiego.edu and attach an electronic copy of the article, series, etc. (where appropriate) or provide a link to where the submission is available online. Please also include the date of publication, the names of the contributors, and contact information.

Nominations must be received by CAI by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 8, 2016.
